TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Annie Jackson
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, my the said Annie Jackson
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 26th day of July 1927

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Six hundred and 20/100 Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 26th day of July A. D. 1927,
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Annie Jackson shall pay or cause to be paid to the said
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of August
1927, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of seven and 00/100

Dollars, (Six Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 6 and 00/100 Shares of stock and 00/100
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the

sum of nine and 20/100 Dollars, (Six Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and three and 20/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);
for the next twenty months the sum of eight and 40/100 Dollars, (Six Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and two and 40/100

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of seven and 00/100
Dollars, (Six Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and one and 00/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the

sum of six and 80/100 Dollars, (Six Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 00/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)
Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 6

shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount of each time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said
Annie Jackson

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Annie Jackson

hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and
