

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, L. A. Floyd

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said L. A. Floyd in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 31st day of March 1928

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Nineteen hundred (\$1,900.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 31st day of March A. D. 1928, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said L. A. Floyd shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of April 1928, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Thirty 7/8 (\$30.08) Dollars, (Nineteen (\$19.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Nineteen Shares of Stock and Eight 7/8 (\$8.08) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty seven 7/8 (\$27.87) Dollars, (Nineteen (\$19.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Eight 7/8 (\$8.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty three 7/8 (\$23.43) Dollars, (Nineteen (\$19.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Six 3/8 (\$6.65) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty three 7/8 (\$23.43) Dollars, (Nineteen (\$19.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and Four 3/8 (\$4.43) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty one 7/8 (\$21.23) Dollars, (Nineteen (\$19.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and Two 3/8 (\$2.23) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 19 shares of stock and the certificate thereon of the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said L. A. Floyd and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said L. A. Floyd in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said L. A. Floyd in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said L. A. Floyd in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

on the south side of Birnie Street in the City of Greenville, described as follows: Beginning at a pin on the south side of Birnie Street, corner of lot sold by me to J. D. Turner, and running thence with the south side of Birnie Street sixty seven and one half (67 1/2) feet, more or less, to lot of E. B. Irvine, thence with Irvine line two hundred eight (208) ft. more or less to League lot, thence with League lot sixty seven and one half feet (67 1/2) more or less, to lot of J. D. Turner, thence with Turner's line two hundred and eight feet (208) ft. more or less, to beginning corner, and being the same; lot conveyed to L. A. Floyd by R. F.
