

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Moses Young of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Moses Young in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 28th day of March 1928

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 28th day of March A. D. 1928, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Moses Young shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of April 1928, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Three + 17/100 (\$3.17) Dollars, (two (\$2.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the two Shares of Stock, and One + 17/100 (\$1.17) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Two + 93/100 (\$2.93) Dollars, (Two (\$2.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 93/100 (\$0.93) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Two + 70/100 (\$2.70) Dollars, (Two (\$2.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 70/100 (\$0.70) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Two + 47/100 (\$2.47) Dollars, (Two (\$2.00) Dollars,

being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 47/100 (\$0.47) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Two + 23/100 (\$2.23) Dollars, (Two (\$2.00) Dollars,

being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 23/100 (\$0.23) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said two shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Moses Young in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Moses Young in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said Moses Young in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina. Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Davis and Foster Streets, and running thence S. 30-30 W. with the line of Davis Street 42 feet to an iron pin corner of lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence S. 65-50 E. 95 feet to an iron pin corner of lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence N. 30-30 E. 40 feet to an iron pin on the edge of Foster Street; thence N. 64-50 W. with the line of Foster Street 95 feet to an iron pin the beginning corner, and being known as Lot No. 11, as shown on the above described survey and plat made by Will D. Neves, July 25, 1914. Plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 226, and being the same land conveyed to Moses Young, by E.E. Watson, by deed dated January 15, 1919, recorded in Vol. 44, page 392, R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County.
