WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

six hundred no/100

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight

per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit: in Greenville

Township, known as lots numbered fifteen and sixteen in Block D of Subdivision known as Summit View, plat of which is recorded in the P. D. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 77, Page 75 each of said lots having a frontage of fifty feet on Redstone Street with a depth and parallel lines of 150 feet to a 10-foot alley. Lot No. 15 was conveyed to R. H. Goddard by C. N. Shaffer by deed dated Oct. 13, 1922, recorded in Book 78, Page 365 and lot No. 16 was conveyed to R. H. Goddard by Anna M. Beatty by deed dated October 13, 1922 and recorded in Book 78, Page 364. Both of said lots were conveyed to Alice E. Goddard by deed dated November 27, 1926, recorded in Book 118, page 544.
