

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Sallie J. Sheek  
 of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send greeting:  
 WHEREAS, I, the said Sallie J. Sheek  
 in and by me, certain note or obligation, bearing date the 31st day of March 1927  
 indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,  
 duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Forty one hundred and no Dollars,  
 with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 31st day of March A. D. 1927,  
 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that  
 the said Sallie J. Sheek shall pay or cause to be paid to the said  
 Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of April 1927,  
 and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Forty eight and 7/10  
 Dollars, (Forty one Dollars,  
 being the regular monthly installment payable on the Forty Shares of Stock, and Twenty seven and 7/10  
 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the  
 sum of Sixty two and 8/10 Dollars, (Forty one  
 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Twenty one and 8/10 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);  
 for the next twenty months the sum of Fifty seven and 8/10 Dollars, (Forty one  
 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Sixteen and 4/10  
 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Forty one and 9/10  
 Dollars, (Forty one Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and  
Ten and 9/10 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the  
 sum of Forty six and 4/10 Dollars, (Forty one Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and  
Five and 4/10 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)  
 Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Forty one  
 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, in amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said  
Sallie J. Sheek and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said  
Sallie J. Sheek in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the  
 said note or obligation, and the condition hereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.  
 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Sallie J. Sheek  
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,  
 according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me  
 the said Sallie J. Sheek in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and  
 Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

"All that piece, parcel and lot of land in  
 Greenville Township, Greenville County, State  
 of South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits  
 of the City of Greenville as shown on the plat of  
 the O. P. Mills property according to a survey by  
 A. E. Dalton, C. & G. in Plat Book 7, page 71, and being  
 more particularly described as follows:  
 Beginning at an iron pipe at the corner  
 corner of lots nos. 1 and 2, Mills Ave., joint  
 S. 44-33 E. 180 feet to a certain point alley; thence  
 S. 45-27 E. 60 feet to joint corner of lots nos. 3 and  
 5; thence N. 44-33 W. 180 feet to Mills Ave., thence  
 with Mills Ave., 45-27 E. 60 feet to the point  
 of beginning and being known and designated  
 as Lot No. 3, block "5" on the above plat re-  
 ferred to. Being the same lot conveyed to me  
 by O. P. Mills, deed dated January 20, 1927, re-  
 corded in Vol. 104, page 386.
