

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Thomas F. Young  
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Thomas F. Young  
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 22nd day of March 1928

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of fourteen hundred and fifty (\$1450.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 22nd day of March A. D. 1928, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Thomas F. Young shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of April 1928, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty-two and 96/100 (\$22.96) Dollars, (fourteen + 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the fourteen Shares of Stock, and Eight + 46/100 (\$8.46) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance of loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-one + 27/100 (\$21.27) Dollars, (fourteen + 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Six + 77/100 (\$6.77) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Nineteen + 58/100 (\$19.58) Dollars, (fourteen + 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Five + 08/100 (\$5.08) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seventeen + 88/100 (\$17.88) Dollars, (fourteen + 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Three + 38/100 (\$3.38) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Sixteen + 18/100 (\$16.18) Dollars, (fourteen + 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and One + 68/100 (\$1.68) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 14 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against, me the said Thomas F. Young in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had as more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Thomas F. Young in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Thomas F. Young

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Beginning in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, being known as Lot No. 104, as shown on a plat of the lands of B.F. Martin, made by C. M. Furman, Surveyor, from a survey of A. A. Schulze, Surveyor, known as Westview Heights, the said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "E", at Page 140, and Lot No. 104 having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the south side of King Street a distance of 424 feet from the intersection of King Street and State Highway No. 8 and running thence along King Street in a northerly direction 61 feet to a corner; thence back in a southerly direction 150 feet to a corner; thence in a southeasterly direction 61 feet to a corner; thence in a northeasterly direction 150 feet to the beginning corner on King Street, being the same lot conveyed to Thomas F. Young by Darrell Sunmugally on April 18, 1925, deed recorded in Vol. 108, Page 55, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.
