in the full and just sum of *eighty one and 92/100 (\$81.92)*  
Dollars, to be paid *Jan 5th 1928*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *Annually*

and in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10%*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount of said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being

bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. J. Freeman*

and County aforesaid, known as the land  
conveyed to me by deed from W. S. Bowers  
the 21st day of February, 1924, adjoining  
lands of B. J. Hunt, W. S. Bowers. Beginning  
on a white oak stump, thence running N  
54 W 1165 to a stone, thence N. 54 1/4 E. 7.90  
to a W. O. T. one, thence down Tub's branch  
to the beginning corner and contains 3.9  
acres more or less.
