bargain, sell and release unto the said **Jennie Goldsmith, her heirs and assigns forever, all the following**  
**described real estate lying and being situated in Fairview Township, State and County**  
**aforesaid, on the south side of the Fork Shoals road leading to Fountain Inn, and being more**  
**fully described as follows: Beginning at a stone on the Fork Shoals Road near dwelling**  
**house, C.G. Thomason corner and running thence S. 6-3/4 W. 3.50 along C.G. Thomason's line**  
**to stone; thence S. 22-3/4 E. 6.89 to stone; thence S. 49 E. 10.84 to stone on Shop Road;**
