until paid in full; all interest and paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount, owed by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this and mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by any attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said K. O. Wright, Sr.

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid,
on the west side of Reedy River and on both
sides of the White Horse Road, about nine (9) miles
from Greenville Court House and about two miles
from Travelers Rest, containing 9 7/8 acres, and
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
beginning at a stake in the middle of the Bridge
over Reedy River and running thence with the meander-
ings of the said stream 23.78 chs. to a stake in the
River; thence S. 60 2/3. 34.00 chs. to a stake in the White
Horse Road; thence S. 13-3/4 2/3. 13.00 chs. to a double pine;
thence S. 84 E. 32.99 to a stone on Road; thence with
said road 15.26 chs. to the beginning corner, as surveyed
by J. N. Southern, on the 3rd day of April, 1903,
and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Book
K. K. K. page 2; reference being had will more fully
