Dollars, to be paid at the rate of \$15.00 per month beginning  
Mar. 15. 27 until paid in full,  
with interest thereon, from date of 13th 1932  
at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent 10%

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being

assigns all that piece or parcel of land situated

State aforesaid, known as 1/2 lot # 4, of John  
Curdine land, fronting on John Street 59 feet and  
4 inches and running back along Callenger line  
18 3/4 feet and 9 inches thence N. 47-21. West and 11  
inches to an iron pin thence S. W. 41.45- W. 185 feet  
and 11 inches to an iron pin, thence along John Street  
59 feet and 4 inches to beginning point This being
