or interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
added to the amount of said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as with more fully appears.
