in the full and just sum of *Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars;*  
Dollars, to be paid *ninety days after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *annually*  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any

bargain, sell and release unto the said *South Carolina National Bank*

*all that piece, parcel and lot of land in Green-*  
*ville Township, Greenville County, State of South*  
*Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the*  
*north side of Park Street described as follows:*  
*Beginning at an iron pin on the north*  
*side of Park Street 63 feet 10 inches from the*  
*west side of Chaback Street, and running*  
*thence with Park Street N. 71-20th. 63 feet, 10*  
*inches to an iron pin; thence N. 18-30 E.*  
*approximately 205 feet to an iron pin on the*  
*south side of Garraus Street; thence with*  
*Garraus Street S. 66-15 E. 64 feet more or less*
