in the full and just sum of Three hundred and noX 100 (\$300.00)

Dollars, to be paid on the 14th, day of April, A.D. 1928

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

\$50.00 besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said H.L. Bell, his heirs and assigns forever: All that certain piece,  
parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, about four miles from Greenville Court house, near and just  
West of the Paris Mt. Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit Beginning at a  
stone, Hubbards and McCarters corner; thence S. 24-3/4 W. 5.27 chs. to Pools corner; thence  
with Pools line S. 61-1/2 E. 7.40 chs. to iron pin X; thence N. 59-3/4 E. 5.95 chs. to iron pin  
on my line; thence N. 61-1/2 W. 9.00 chs. to the beginning corner, containing 4-1/10 acres,  
more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Mrs. M.A. Bryant by deed
