WHEREAS, I, the said H. Virgil Heath

in the full and just sum of Four hundred fifty and no/100  
Dollars, to be paid of four years from date, interest to be paid annually

with interest thereon, from date #17883 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said H. Virgil Heath

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

T.W. Moon

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

H. Virgil Heath

in hand well and truly paid by the said T.W. Moon

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said T.W. Moon, All that piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being

in Highland Township, in the State and County aforesaid, metes and bounds as follows: Beginning  
at a stake at intersection of road leading out from house on land sold to Virgil Heath Sept.  
21st, 1926 into Greenville Road; thence along said Greenville road to line between T.W. Moon  
and Thomas Lindsey; thence along said line S. 66 E. to large red oak; thence N. 66 E. 6.75  
chs. to stone; thence N. 22 E. 19.75 chs. to a stone; thence N. 89 W. to branch; thence up  
and with meanderings of said branch to Spring; thence a southerly direction to the beginning  
corner being a part of a tract of land conveyed to me by Thomas Forrester and known as the  
J.R. Moon place, containing twenty five acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Thomas Lindsey  
W.M. Barton, T.W. Moon.

Whereas, my husband, J. W. Moon, during his life time  
collected in full from H. Virgil Heath, the note secured by the within  
mortgage for \$450.00, and turned said note and mortgage over to said  
H. Virgil Heath but failed to mark said mortgage paid. That  
said J. W. Moon thereafter died, and I knowing said note and  
mortgage to have been paid in full, authorize the R. M. C. for Greenville  
County to mark said mortgage satisfied of record, Nov. 29, 1940.
