of South Carolina, on the west side of North
Main Street, beginning at a point 23 feet, more
or less, south of the southwest corner of West
Coffee St. and North Main Street, and running
thence with said North Main Street in a
southerly direction 23 feet, more or less; thence
in a westerly direction 90 feet, more or less; thence
in a northerly direction 23 feet, more or less;
thence in an easterly direction 90 feet, more or
less, to the beginning corner. Being the same
