I, Walter Stow, of the County and State aforesaid SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Walter Stow  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

A.D.L. Barksdale  
in the full and just sum of Six hundred (\$600.00)  
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Walter Stow  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said A.D.L. Barksdale

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Walter Stow  
in hand well and truly paid by the said A.D.L. Barksdale

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A.D.L. Barksdale, all that certain lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, beginning at a point in Poole's Alley 125 feet and 6 inches from corner of Mulberry Street and Poole's Alley, and running thence southerly 26-08 E. 41 and 6/10 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction 99 feet to iron pin on back line; thence in a northwestern direction 40 feet to iron pin on corner of Mulberry Street lot, back line; thence in a southerly direction 97 feet and 6 inches to the beginning corner; being the same lot of land this day conveyed to me by said A.D.L. Barksdale. This mortgage is given to secure the payment of the credit part of the purchase money.
