All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate,
lying and being in Chick Springs Township, near
the town of Greer, State and County aforesaid, desig-
nated as lots Nos. 1 and 2 on plat prepared by H. N.
Willis December 10th, 1915, of Cunningham Heights, each
lot having a frontage of 5 feet, on the old National
Highway, a depth of 197 on the East side, 197 feet on
Dorner Avenue, with a 15 foot alley in back of said
lots, same being lots of land conveyed to me by
J. L. Hawkins and yet to be recorded.

Also that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land
in Chick Springs Township, county and state aforesaid
