We, Joe P Jamison and Ruth Jamison of Greenville County, S.C. SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said Joe P Jamison and Ruth Jamison in and by our certain obligation or note in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

J. F. Gallivan in the full and just sum of Fifteen hundred (\$15000) Dollars Dollars, to be paid one year after date thereof.

with interest thereon, from 22nd day of July, 1927 computed and paid at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually from said 22nd day of July until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

on said amount besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All that certain piece or parcel or lot of land, situate, being and lying in Butler Township, Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina, and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin, in edge of Lounds Hill Road and running thence, N. 13-1/2 N., three hundred and fifty eight (358) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-1/2 E., one hundred and twenty three (123) feet to the beginning corner and containing one acre, more or less; and being the same property conveyed to us by Arch Jamison by deed dated the 14th day of March, A.D. 1927, but not yet recorded; and the same land on which we have recently built a five room brick house, now occupied by us; an iron pin; thence S. 13-1/2 E., three hundred and fifty eight (358) feet to an iron pin in edge of said road; thence along edge of said road, N. 81-1/2 N., one hundred and twenty three (123) feet to the beginning corner and containing one acre, more or less; and being the same property conveyed to us by Arch Jamison by deed dated the 14th day of March A.D. 1927, but not yet recorded; and the same land on which we have recently built a five room brick house, now occupied by us.
