SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Will Goode*
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *Two hundred eighty seven and 50/100 (\$287.50)*
Dollars, to be paid *January 9, 1929*

with interest thereon, from *Jan. 9, 1928*
computed and paid *annually* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder
hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Fifty dollars*
(\$50.00) besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *J. A. Poe*
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. A. Poe* his heirs and assigns all

that piece or parcel or lot of land situated on west side
of *Wartool Street* near *Jenkins St.* in the City of Greenville
S. C. and being No. *9* according to a plat re-
corded in *G. M. C. Office* in said State and County
in Plat Book "A" page *54* and having the following
dimensions according to said plat: having a frontage
of *48* ft on said *Street* and a depth of *95* ft. or *48 x 95*-
ft, now containing a six room house and being
the same house and lot *J. Goode* bought from *J. M.*
