

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 85-776

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered to The Prudential Ins Co of America by Eleanor F. Hudgens and R. H. Hudgens The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated May 1, 1922, 19, and recorded in said County on May 4, 1922, in Volume 123 of Mortgages on Page 9, in the sum of Thirty five hundred (3,500.00) Dollars, with interest from May 1, 1927, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Eleanor F. Hudgens and R. H. Hudgens subject to said mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Eleanor F. Hudgens and R. H. Hudgens hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

On the first day of each month beginning on the first day of June 1927 the sum of Twenty-five (25.00) Dollars, to be applied on the principal of said amount due on said note and also, at the same times, interest at the rate of six (6%) per cent, per annum on the balances of said principal remaining due thereon on the said first day of each month, and on the first day of May 1932, the balance of said principal sum with interest thereon; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note. Additional payments of not less than four hundred dollars (\$400) at any one payment, per multiples of the monthly instalment of principal, may be made on the principal at any

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
