

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 120981

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by

to Helen M. Smith
The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated March 8th, 1929, and recorded in said County on March 8th, 1929, in Volume 123 of mortgages on Page 237, in the sum of Thirty-Two Hundred (\$3,200.00) Dollars, with interest from March 8th, 1929, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Helen M. Smith

subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Helen M. Smith

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars One, Two, Three and Four years after date, and (the balance of Two Thousand Five Hundred Sixty (\$2,560.00) Dollars, five years after date,

with interest thereon from March 8th, 1929, to March 8th, 1934, at the rate of five and one half per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or any multiple thereof on the principal of said note at any interest payment date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said

shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
