

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO A-133150

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by

to Gilman J. Thompson mortgage upon real estate in the city of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, dated August 26th, 1924, and recorded in said County on August 27, 1924, in Volume 123 of Mortgages on Page 35, in the sum of Seventeen Hundred Fifty Dollars, with interest from August 1st, 1924, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Gilman J. Thompson

subject to said mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Gilman J. Thompson

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: on the first day of each month beginning on the first day of September 1929, the sum of Twelve & 50/100 (\$12.50) Dollars to be applied on the principal of said amount due on said note, and also at the same times, interest at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum on the balances of said principal remaining due thereon on the said first day of each month, and on the first day of August 1934, the balance of said principal sum with interest thereon, and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note

with interest thereon from _____, 19____, to _____, 19____, at the rate of _____ per cent per annum, payable _____ annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Additional payments of not less than one Hundred Dollars (\$100) at any one payment in multiples of the monthly instalment of principal may be made on the principal at any interest-payment date, and the amount so paid shall be credited on said principal

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage

shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
