

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 141165

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Homer L. Todd to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated December 17th, 1924, and recorded in said County on January 20, 1925, in Volume 123 of Mortgages on Page 244, in the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars, with interest from December 17th, 1924, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Homer L. Todd subject to said mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Homer L. Todd hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars one year after date, Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars two years after date, Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars three years after date, Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars four years after date, and Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars five years after date. with interest thereon from December 17, 1929 to December 17, 1934, at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, payable annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
