

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 158091

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Frances M. Withington to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated September 18th, 1925, and recorded in said County on September 19, 1925, in Volume 123 of mortgages on Page 275, in the sum of Four thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars, with interest from September 18, 1930, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Frances M. Withington subject to said mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Frances M. Withington and Chas. C. Withington hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

\$ 250.00 on September 18, 1931; \$ 250.00 on September 18, 1932; \$ 250.00 on September 18, 1933; \$ 250.00 on September 18, 1934; and \$ 3,000.00 on September 18, 1935;

with interest thereon from September 18, 1930, to September 18, 1935, at the rate of five and one half per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of said note in sums of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars on multiples thereof.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

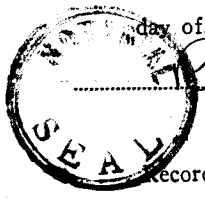
