

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 64187

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Catista S. Cleveland to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a Mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated December 3, 1925, and recorded in said County on December 15, 1925, in Volume 471 of Real Estate Mortgages Page 10, in the sum of Thirty Five Hundred (3,500.00) Dollars, with interest from December 3, 1925, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Catista S. Cleveland subject to said Mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Catista S. Cleveland hereby agree s to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

\$87.50 on June 3, 1931; \$87.50 on December 3, 1931; \$87.50 on June 3, 1932; \$87.50 on December 3, 1932; \$87.50 on June 3, 1933; \$87.50 on December 3, 1933; \$87.50 on June 3, 1934; \$87.50 on December 3, 1934; \$87.50 on June 3, 1935; and \$2,712.50 on December 3, 1935; with interest thereon from December 3, 1930, to December 3, 1935, at the rate of five and one-half percent, per annum, payable Residual annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of this note in sums of \$100.00 or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said Mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and Mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
