

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 171168

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Elizabeth L Laval

to

The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in

Greenville County, South Carolina, dated March 12, 1926, and recorded in said

County on March 13, 1926, in Volume 123 of Mortgages on Page 45, in the sum of

Twenty-eight Hundred (\$2800.) Dollars,

with interest from March 1, 1931, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Elizabeth L Laval

subject to said mortgage

and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Elizabeth L Laval and William L Laval hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

On the first day of each month beginning on the first day of April, 1931, the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to be applied on the principal of said amount due on said note, and also at the same time interest at the rate of six (6%) percent per annum on the balances of with interest thereon from said principal remaining due, at the rate of ...

first day of each month, and on the first day of March 1936, the balance of said principal sum with interest thereon, and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note. Additional payments in multiple of the monthly installment of principal may be made on the principal at any interest payment date, and the amount so paid shall be credited on said principal

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
