

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 181964

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by C. F. Haynsworth

to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated July 12, 1926, and recorded in said County on July 13, 1931, 19... in Volume 172 of Mortgages, on Page 8, in the sum of Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred (\$14,400.00) Dollars, with interest from July 12, 1931, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in C. F. Haynsworth

subject to said mortgage. and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said C. F. Haynsworth and wife, Elsie Hall Haynsworth, hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

\$360.00 on January 12, 1932; \$360.00 on July 12, 1932;
\$360.00 on January 12, 1933; \$360.00 on July 12, 1933;
\$360.00 on January 12, 1934; \$360.00 on July 12, 1934;
\$360.00 on January 12, 1935; \$360.00 on July 12, 1935;
\$360.00 on January 12, 1936; \$11,160.00 on July 12, 1936;
with interest thereon from July 12, 1931, to July 12, 1936, at the rate of five and one-half per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of said note in sums of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
