

Green River to a Hickory on the north bank of said river; thence n. 29.15- w. about 75- feet to contour elevation line 925- feet; thence continuing with the meanders of said contour elevation line in a northerly and easterly direction until it intersects with the line between the Elbert Jackson place and the James Jackson place, near Rattens Creek, said tract being deeded by James Jackson to Joseph Lee, Sept. 10, 1907, and recorded in Book # 24, page 3, said Register's Office; thence continuing with said contour 925- over said James Jackson tract up Rattens Creek, crossing said creek, and continuing in a South Easterly direction, crossing the line of Eli Jackson place, and continuing with said contour elevation 925- feet in an easterly direction, and leaving an island in bend of river, to the C. H. Ruppe Tract, said Eli Jackson place having been deeded by Eli Jackson to Joseph Lee August 22, 1907, and recorded in Book # 24, page 322, said Register's Office; thence continuing with said contour elevation line 925- feet in an easterly direction over the land deeded by C. H. Ruppe and others to Joseph Lee, Sept. 26, 1907, and recorded in Book # 24, page 36, said Register's Office, and from J. B. Turner to Joseph Lee, May 14, 1907, and recorded in Book # 23, page 83, said Register's Office, to the land deeded by Hester Browning and others, Sept. 10, 1907, and Dec. 20, 1907, and recorded in Book # 24, pages 316 and 318, said Register's Office; thence continuing with said contour elevation line 925- feet in an easterly direction over said lands to lands deeded by F. E. Whitesides to Manufacturers Power Company, Jan. 28, 1914, and recorded in Book # 33, page 46, said Register's Office; thence continuing with said contour elevation line 925- feet in an easterly direction over said lands to stake; thence n. 77.20 E. 132 feet to stake on property line; thence with said property line S. 32.40 E. 798 feet to stake; thence S. 46.45 E. 1057 feet crossing Green River to White Oak on South bank of said river; thence up and with the line of the river S. 39 1/2. 680 feet to stake near mouth of Hitching Creek, n. 57.36 w. 548 feet to iron pin, the point of beginning, containing three hundred and ten (310) acres, more or less.
