

Beginning on a stone, about 40 feet from the South bank of Green River, old corner of the Foster and Hamilton Estate Tracts; thence with line of said Hamilton Estate, S. 27.30 E. about 60 feet to contour elevation line 925 feet (reference M. S. G. S. B. M. 105-3, near Hamilton Bridge); thence with the meanders of said contour elevation line 925 feet, in a Southwesterly direction, crossing the old Mills Gap Road, about 105.00 feet to the west line of said Foster Place, and the South bank of said Green River; thence crossing said Green River N. 22.45 W. about 100 feet; thence continuing with said contour elevation line 925 feet in a northeasterly direction, crossing Bright's Creek, about 85.00 feet to the line between the A. M.
