Eighth Lot.

All that lot or parcel of land in Spartanburg county, South Carolina, within the corporate limits of the city of Spartanburg, on the south west side of Howard Street - beginning at a stake and running thence S. 37.40 W. 277.8 ft. with the center line of a common driveway 18 feet wide, thence N. 51.15 W. 94 feet to a stake on line of property formerly belonging to the estate of F.
