

and  $4/10$  feet ( $26^{\circ}15'360.4$  ft.) to stone on branch; thence south forty-nine degrees no minutes east one hundred sixty-one feet ( $49^{\circ}0'E. 161$  ft.) to stone on old road; thence north forty-six degrees no minutes east ( $46^{\circ}0'E.$ ) down old road to turn; thence north forty degrees no minutes east ( $40^{\circ}0'E.$ ) to stone and cedar tree, the latter two courses being one thousand feet (1000 ft.); thence south sixty-six degrees no minutes east twenty-one hundred feet ( $66^{\circ}0'E. 2100$  ft.) to pipe; thence north forty-eight degrees thirty minutes east eleven hundred sixty-five feet ( $48^{\circ}30'E. 1165$  ft.) to pipe corner at end of old rock dam; thence across said river and up the east bank thereof to beginning stone.
