

Town of Fair Forest in the County of Spartanburg and State of South Carolina, to the sub-station located in the City of Greer in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, and all poles and lines of wire in connection with said transmission line, together with the complete outdoor sub-station equipment, including transformers, lightning arresters, disconnecting switches, and other equipment pertaining to this sub-station.

Being the same premises conveyed to Broad River Power Company by the Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greer by deed dated March 7, 1927, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on March 8, 1927, in Book 7-A, page 600, and in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, on March 18, 1927, in Deed Book 111, page 464, and in the Office of the Auditor for Greenville County, South Carolina, on March 18, 1927, in Book 1, page 484.

Parcel Number Fourteen.

All that transmission line, together with the easements, rights, privileges, rights of way and all poles, towers, wires, transformers, meters and appurtenances thereto, described as follows:

Tower line from East Spartanburg sub-station ~~to~~ to a point approximately two miles west of Union, South Carolina, said point being tower No. 364 on said tower line, and continuing up to but not including said tower No. 364.

Also, all property, real, personal and mixed, including all franchises, transmission lines, leases, easements, rights, privileges and rights of way, owned by Broad River Power Company and located and situated in the Counties of Polk, Henderson and Rutherford, in the State of North Carolina, and in the Counties of Spartanburg, Laurens, Greenville and Cherokee, in the State of South Carolina, and north and west of the East Spartanburg substation of said Broad River Power Company.
