

stake; South 61 East 99 feet- to a stake; South 81 East 66 feet- to a stake; north 72 East 445.5 feet- to a stake; north 40 East 104.5 feet- to a stake; north 32.30 West, about 225 feet- to a stake in said water line contour, near said Bell's maple corner, near Station 319, on said Cadshaw map; Thence with the meanders of said water line contour to the Beginning stake; containing 1.1 acre more or less, and being a portion of the tract of land conveyed to J. O. Bell by N. F. Walker, by deed recorded in said Office in Deed Book 90, page 119.

#### Sixth Lot.

Beginning at a rock on the north bank of Green River, under a cliff marked with a cross; thence crossing and down the river, with its meanders, to corner of the Hart Tract, on south bank of said river; thence with Bell-Hart line, about 100 feet- to a stake in water line contour elevation 2010 feet, datum referred to, near Station 414, as shown on said Cadshaw map; thence with the meanders of said contour line to a stake in said Bell line on said contour line, near Station 390, as shown on said Cadshaw map; Thence north 59 East about 500 feet- to two small chestnuts; thence north 71.30 East 379 feet- to a stake in the old road from Mountain Page to Jeremia; thence South 36 East 45 feet- to a stake in said road; Thence north 33 East 119 feet- to a stake in said road; Thence north 74.45 East 192 feet- to a stake in said road, in line of said Bell-Dease Tract; thence with said line, north 1.30 East 95 feet- to maple and chestnut near river bank; thence crossing Green River in a northerly direction 99 feet- to a double birch in the middle of the old road at Peris' Ford; thence up the north bank, with its meanders, about 742.5 feet- to a bunch of maples on the north bank, H. C. Hard's heirs' corner; thence with said Hard line, north 6.2' N. about 220 feet- to a stake in said contour line on north side of river, near Station 266, as shown on said Cadshaw map; thence with the meanders of said contour line to a stake in line of said Bell's Church and School House Lot, between Stations 233 and 234 of said contour on said Cadshaw map; Thence South 14 West about 200 feet- to the White Oak
