Eighth Lot

All that lot, or parcel of land in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, within the corporate limits of the City of Spartanburg, on the southwest side of Howard Street beginning at a stake and running thence S. 37.40 W. 277.8 feet with the center line of a common driveway 18 feet wide, thence N. 51.15 W. 94 feet to a stake on line of property formerly belonging to the estate of F. M. Trimmier, deceased thence N. 37.40 E. 277.4 feet with the line of said Trimmier property to a stake on the west side of Howard Street and thence with Howard Street S. 51.15 E. 94 feet to the beginning corner; being bounded on the north by the Trimmier Estate, on the east by Howard Street, on the south by common driveway, and on the west by Spartan Mills, being the property upon which the Substation is now established, all of which will more fully appear by map of H. N. Hillis, C. E. dated November 7, 1923, and April 20, 1926, being the same property conveyed to Manufacturers Power Company, May 5, 1926, by Spartan Mills.

Ninth Lot

All that certain lot or parcel of land in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, beginning at a point in Archer Road, N. 28° 29' E. 45-0 ft. from the N. E. corner of Liberty Street and Beauchamp Street, as shown on Plat Book 5; at page 189 of the records of Spartanburg County, said front being 1200 feet at right angles from the original center line of the C. C. & O. Railroad, thence parallel with the original center line of the C. C. & O. Railroad, N. 42° 45' E. 675- ft. more or less, to the center of Lawson's Fork; thence up Lawson's Fork 600 ft. more or less, to a point opposite large white oak tree; thence S. 31° 40' W. 197 1/4 ft. to the west side of Archer Road; thence S. 29° 53' E.
