

Fifth Lot.

Also including all houses, dams and power plants on the above described properties, and including specifically within the power plant - five 2200 volt - three phase 60 cycle Westinghouse generators, three 400 KVA General Electric Company water cooled 60 cycle transformers, three S. Morgan Smith Company water wheels, two Babcock-Hilcox Company 230 H.P. boilers, one 400 KVA 3 phase 60 cycle Westinghouse Electric and Manufacturing Company Steam turbine, six slate panels for control equipment, 2 D.C. exciters, 25-KW each and including also approximately twenty-five miles of distribution lines and twenty seven and 35/100 (27.35) miles of transmission lines.
