even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *one thousand two hundred and fifty (\$1250)*  
Dollars, to be paid *one year after date thereof.*

with interest thereon, from *the 10th day of Nov. A.D. 1927* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *semi-annually*

.....until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of princi-  
pal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *five per cent on*  
*said amount* besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note....., reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. F. Gallivan* All that certain piece, parcel or lot

of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on  
the South side of Stone Avenue, between Main and Townes Streets, being the western half  
of lot No. 2 of lands formerly belonging to Eugenia A. Stone, deceased, according to a  
survey made by J.N. Southern and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County Vol.  
V.V., page 542; the said lot has a frontage of sixty feet and nine inches and a depth of  
one hundred sixty-four feet and is bounded on the North by stone avenue on the East, now or  
formerly of R.M. MacDonald, on the South by lands now or formerly of Mrs. M.A. Mooney, and  
on the West by lot sold to W.E. McCain; and is the same lot conveyed to me, Florence A.-
