SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said *R. R. Williams*
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

C. P. Phillips
in the full and just sum of *Four hundred*
Dollars, to be paid *Three years from Date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *1.00*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *C. P. Phillips*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said *C. P. Phillips*

all that parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in Chick's Springs township and in the State and County aforesaid and on a south branch of Morrow Creek branch waters of Enoree River adjoining lands of C. E. Shockley, Beattie Smith, R. R. Williams and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on iron pin on C. E. Shockley line thence N. 79 E. 1.32 Chains to sweet gum; thence S. 86 1/4 E. 1.86 chains to sweet gum; thence S. 88 1/4 E. 4.18 chains to iron pin at dead pine; thence S. 1 1/2 W. 1.97 chains to iron pin; thence N. 80 3/4 W. 6.66 chains to beginning corner and containing one (1) acre, more or less; according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman July 23, 1925 (And
