SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *we*, the said *W M Thompson and Thomas Keating*  
in and by *our* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*The Liberty Life Insurance Company*  
in the full and just sum of *Twenty five Thousand and no/100*  
Dollars, to be paid *five years after date, with privilege of*  
*pre-payment in multiples of one thousand*  
*(\$1,000) dollars on any interest date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *5 1/2* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent*

added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *W M Thompson and Thomas Keating*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

*The Liberty Life Insurance Company*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of *Three Dollars*, to  
*W M Thompson and Thomas Keating*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *The Liberty Life*  
*Insurance Company*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
tain, sell and release unto the said *The Liberty Life Insurance Company*

*its successors and assigns, all that certain piece*  
*parcel or lot of land, together with the improvements*  
*thereon, situated in the City of Greer, County and State*  
*of South Carolina, on the West side of Trade Street and more*  
*particularly described as follows:*

*Beginning at point on West side of said Trade Street*  
*at corner of Sexton property and running thence*  
*S 79 W. 109 feet to point; thence N 59 W. 42.5 feet*  
*to point on alley; thence along the Eastern side of*  
*said alley, S 34 W. 45 feet to point; thence S 8*  
*57.15 E. 26.7 feet to point; thence N. 79-15 E. 21.8 feet to*  
*point; thence N. 84 E. 23.7 feet to point; thence S. 10-30 E.*  
*25.7 feet to point; thence N 79-30 E. 109.5 feet to point*
