at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Bank of Taylors, its successors and assigns  
all of my certain tract of land situate in Traylor parcel of land situate in O'Neal Township, Greenville County and more or less, and bounded by its own or former owners of T. B. Brown and S. H. Libbott, and being more completely described as follows:  
Beginning on an iron pin in the old Rutherford Road and running thence along said old road N. 63.62. 1027.77 feet to an iron pin on bank of New Rutherford Road, thence N. 82.45. 1365 feet to an iron pin on East bank of branch, thence up the meanders of said branch N. 4.10. 138 feet to bend, thence N. 61.32. 183 feet to bend in branch; thence N. 3.49. 116.5 feet to bend; thence N. 21.35. 109 feet to bend; thence N. 50. 61.5 feet to iron pin on line of land now or formerly of T. B. Brown, 15 feet from the center of branch; thence along said line N. 89. 1280 feet to iron pin in center of branch; thence down said branch S. 42.30. 277 feet to bend in branch; thence S. 18.40. 55.5 to bend in branch; thence S. 78.05. 93 feet to White Oak (down in branch); thence S. 12.11. 1297 feet to stone right of large poplar; thence S. 40.33.5 feet to East Oak; thence S. 84.25. 1743.5 feet to the beginning corner, according to survey and plat made by V. S. Beckman, Surveyor, on the 31st day of October, 1926, reference to said plat being hereto made for a more complete description of said lands, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. C. Roe by Annie C. Roe, Vol. 24, Page 251, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by the said J. C. Roe, by deed dated November 16th, 1926, and recorded in the R. M. C.
