Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, from _____ at the rate of _____ per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent (10%)*

added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under the mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *Charlie Dymit*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot no. 36 on plat of land of B. F. Martin by C. M. Furman, Surveyor, from survey of N. A. Schuyler, Surveyor, known as "West View," said plat being recorded in Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" page 140; said lot having a frontage of fifty (50) feet, more or less on the west side of King Street, and a depth of one hundred, fifty (150) feet, as shown by said plat. The lot herein conveyed is Lot number thirty-six.

The premises herein conveyed are the same as con-veyed to H. D. Osterhardt and J. O. Heatherly by deed dated January 13, 1927, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 104, page 378, and the said H. D. Osterhardt thereafter, on August 17, 1927, conveyed his interest to the said Fred B. Jordan by deed recorded in Deed Book 130 page 112.
