interest be at any time not due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may

east, and bounded by School Street on the South
Southwest and West; and by lands of
the Davenport Estate on the North and North
east, containing three fourths of an acre,

and being known as the home of the late
L. H. Littlefield, having been conveyed to him
