SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *John Green*
in and by *my* certain *promissory*
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *Five hundred twenty five*
Dollars, to be paid *February 7th 1929*

with interest thereon, from *date Paid 10th of January 1929* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *John Green*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *J. F. Manos*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

John Green in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. F. Manos*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. F. Manos*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying being in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a point on John Street, being the west corner of the Reese lot, and running thence with John Street N. 50 1/2 W. 253 feet to an iron stake near branch; thence N. 52 E. 115 feet to a point marked with an iron stake; thence S. 50 1/2 E. 229 feet to a stake on line of said Reese lot; thence with said Reese line, S. 39 1/2 W. 115 feet to the beginning point on John Street, and being the same lot conveyed to me by John J. Bramlett, Master, Dec 28, 1914 deed recorded in Vol. 14, page 223.
