WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Narcissa J. Stroud*
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

H. K. Tourner, Attorney
in the full and just sum of *Three hundred fifty and no/100 (\$350.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *two years after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *4* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to be interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount of principal and interest to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *five (\$5.00)*
dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

Court house on the Sumner Road or the Hendersonville
