SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *J. H. Harrison*, the said *J. H. Harrison*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *The*  
*Woodside National Bank of Greenville, S.C.*  
in the full and just sum of *Twenty-one hundred eighty-five & 5/100 (\$2,185.50)*  
Dollars, to be paid *upon Nov 15-th 1928*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *semi-annually*  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Ten per cent*  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) as in and by the said note reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. H. Harrison* the said *J. H. Harrison*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *The Woodside National Bank*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said  
*J. H. Harrison* in hand well and truly paid by the said *The Woodside National Bank*  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *The Woodside National Bank, its successors*

*and assigns:* All that certain tract of land in Fairview Township, County and State  
aforesaid, known as the John Harrison place, containing 91 acres, more or less, and having the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3x in bank of branch next to the  
lands of S.E. Harrison and running thence S. 87-1/2 E. 51.62 to a stone; thence S. 60-1/2 E. 5.00  
to a stone; thence S. 45 W. 32.00 to a stone; thence N. 60-1/4 - 44.65 to a stone on bank of  
the branch; thence with the meanderings of said branch 7.00 to the beginning corner, bounded  
by lands now or formerly of Richard Harrison, S.E. Harrison and J.H. Harrison, Jr.  
Also, all that other tract of land in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, being  
known as the Homestead tract of John H. Harrison, Sr., containing 100 acres, more or less, and  
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on stone near the middle of Jenkins  
Bridge Road, and running thence N. 33-1/2 W. 34.80 to large P.O. 3xom; thence N. 60-1/2 W. 6.45  
to stone 3x; thence S. 46 W. 31.51 to stone on Richard Harrison's line; thence S. 60-1/2 E.  
40.80 to stone on Jenkins Bridge Road; thence N. 54-3/4 E. 12.36 to stone on road; thence N.  
37 E. 3.72 to the beginning corner, bounded by lands now or formerly of Richard Harrison,  
D.P. Cox and James Henderson.
