SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I Margaret Ella Forest Poole,  
in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

The Woodside National Bank of Greenville, S. C.  
in the full and just sum of Seven hundred fifty + no/100 (\$750.00)  
Dollars, to be paid November 15th 1928

with interest thereon, from maturity date, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten Per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I Margaret Ella Forest Poole,  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Woodside

National Bank  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Margaret Ella Forest Poole,  
in hand, well and truly paid by the said The Woodside National

Bank, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said The Woodside National Bank, its successors  
and assigns:

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land  
situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, County and  
State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds  
to-wit: Beginning at a rock on the west side of Mush  
Creek Road, and running thence N. 77 1/2 W. 21.15 chains  
to a rock; thence S. 71 W. 17.70 chains to a rock; thence  
N. 59 W. 10.07 chains to a rock com; thence S. 89 1/5 E. 9.70  
chains to a stake; thence N. 1 E. 22.31 chains to a rock  
on New Branch; thence S. 87 E. 17.27 chains to a rock com;  
thence S. 6.40 to a rock; thence S. 55 E. 24.90 chains to a  
rock; thence 22 N. 5.10 chains to the beginning corner  
containing 6 3/4 acres, more or less.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land  
in Saluda Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining  
the above-described tract, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a Poplar tree;  
thence S. 88 W. 16.20 to a stake; thence S. 2 E. 2.50 to a rock  
com; thence S. 55 E. 24.50 to the middle of Mush Creek  
Road; thence N. 1 E. along said road 8.65 to fork of road;  
thence N. 32 W. 5.72 to the bend; thence N. 18 W. 3.66 to the  
beginning corner, containing 17 1/2 acres, more or less.

me by E. Inman, master, by deed dated August 12th,  
1924, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville  
County, in vol. 94, Page 232. It is understood that this  
mortgage constitutes a first lien over the above
