WHEREAS, *we*, the said *C. N. Cason and Martha Etta Cason*
in and by *our* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *one thousand (\$1,000.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*

with interest thereon, from _____ at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time *paid* and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent*
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *Peoples National Bank, Trustee for Bernice Endel*.

All that certain tract of land in the State and County aforesaid on Easley Bridge Road, about four and one half miles from Greenville Court House, containing ten and 5/100 (10.54) acres, more or less; being the same tract of land conveyed to Mrs. M. E. Cason by Annie Mae Braubt by deed dated March 19, 1919, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol 34 Page 671, reference being made to said deed for a full description by metes and bounds.
