WHEREAS, I, the said J. H. Jacks

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid Annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (any of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said N. A. Henderson

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of
land, situated, lying and being in Fairview
Township, County of State aforesaid, containing
171.5 Acres, more or less, bounded by
lands of estate of S. E. Harrison lands of
the late J. H. Anderson on the by Reddy
River on the north by the Jenkins Bridge
Road, and being the square tract of land
conveyed to me by The Peoples National
Bank of Greenville, S. C. by deed dated Dec
31st 1923 and recorded in the office of
