certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in what is known as City View, and fronting 50 feet on Smith Street, beginning 153.6 feet from new cut road, and having a depth on one side of 189 feet and on the other side of 194.10 feet, being known and designated as Lot No. 10, of Block J, Plat of City View Land Company, Plat Book A, page 327. This being the same lot of land conveyed to Mary J. Heath by J.C. Peace, by deed dated May 1st, 1915, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 38, page 9.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, being part of the subdivision known as City View, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin 203 feet 6 inches from the corner of the New Cut Road and Smith Street, and running thence in an easterly direction 199 feet 10 inches to a stake; thence in a northerly direction 50 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction 198 feet 10 inches to a stake on Smith Street; thence in a Southerly direction 50 feet along Smith Street to the beginning corner, and being known as Lot No. 9-A of Block J, of City View Land Company.
