We, *Mary Styles and Corrie Stewart*

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *we*, the said *Mary Styles and Corrie Stewart*  
in and by *our* certain *Promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*R. P. Turner*  
in the full and just sum of *Seven Hundred Sixty Seven + 67/100 (\$767.60)*  
Dollars, to be paid *On December 13, 1928, Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars*  
*and Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars on the 13th of each*  
*thereafter until paid in full*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*ten per cent* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *we* the said *Mary Styles and Corrie Stewart*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *us*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *R. P. Turner*

Those certain lots of land, with the improve-  
ments thereon in which Spring Township, said  
County and State, near Greer, S. C. and designated  
as Lots 50, 51 and 52 on plat of "Morrow Park"  
and conveyed to J. N. Styles and J. R. Styles by  
C. S. Styles by deed of Sept. 18th, 1918, recorded in  
Vol. 45, Page 56, and J. R. Styles having conveyed  
his interest therein to me by deed recorded  
in Vol. 56, Page 559.

Also, those two certain lots in said Township,  
County and State, designated as lots 53 and  
54 on said "Morrow Park" plat which is record-  
ed in said County in Plat Book E, Page 91, and  
conveyed by J. E. Nesupley to J. N. Styles, by deed
