SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *we*, the said *R.S. Burchette and Mary Burchette*
in and by *our* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *are* well and truly indebted to

The Carolina Loan and Trust Company
in the full and just sum of *Two Hundred (200)*
Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Twenty five (\$25.00)*
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *we* the said *R.S. Burchette and Mary Burchette*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *The Carolina*
Loan and Trust Company
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *us*, the said
R.S. Burchette and Mary Burchette
in hand well and truly paid by the said *The Carolina Loan &*
Trust Company

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said *The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,*
its heirs and assigns forever, all that certain
lot of land about two and one-half miles south-
east of the City of Greenville, in subdivision known
as Fallis Annex, said tract being known and
designated as Lot No. 5 according to a plat of W.D.
Neves, Engineer, dated March, 1913, and recorded
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in
Plat Book C, at page 151, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the west side of
Bradley Street 50 feet from corner of Carl Drive and
running thence S. 64° 35' W. 320 feet to a stake; thence
S. 24° E. 100 feet to a pin; thence N. 64° 35' E. 320 feet to a
pin on Bradley Street; thence with said street
N. 24° W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being the
same lot conveyed to us, R.S. Burchette and Mary
Burchette, by C.A. Turner, by deed dated December
9, 1926, recorded in Vol. 104, page 349, R.M.C. Office
for said Greenville County.
